4. A motion was made by Walter Hancock, seconded by Marie Thomas, recommending that the agenda be approved. Motion unanimously carried.

The Contract shall include appropriate behavior and no tolerance regarding violations of a serious nature.

Should the student seriously violate the contract, readmission will be revoked, the expulsion order will continue to be in force, and the Principal has the authority to immediately refer the student to the Palermo Community Day School until the end of the 2006/2007 school year for school attendance.

Should the student seriously violate the contract, readmission will be revoked, the expulsion order will continue to be in force, and the Principal has the authority to immediately refer the student to the Palermo Community Day School until the end of the 2006/2007 school year for school attendance.

ACTIONS ITEMS

7. Action on Expulsion Case No. 01/22/92, I.D. No. 61594.

a. Action No. 1 - Finding of Fact.

A motion was made by Susan Short, seconded by Marie Thomas, that Student No. 01/22/92, I.D. No. 61594 did, in fact, successfully complete the rehabilitation plan and contract.

Motion unanimously carried.

b. Action No. 2 - Readmission to Palermo School.

A motion was made by Susan Short, seconded by Walter Hancock, to readmit Student No. 01/22/92, I.D. No. 61594 to Palermo School under a Behavior Contract developed by the Principal, through the end of the 2006/2007 school year.

Should the student fail to meet the conditions of contract, the student's readmission will be revoked, the expulsion order will continue to be in force, and the student will be immediately referred to the Palermo Community Day School until the end of the 2006/2007 school year for school attendance.

Motion unanimously carried.

CLOSED SESSION

The Board recessed into closed session at 6:50 p.m. for the purpose of discussing Student Matters/Discipline, in accordance with Education Code Sections 49073 and 49076, regarding Expulsion Case No. 3/27/93, I.D. No 82112.

OPEN SESSION

The Board reconvened into open session at 7:26 p.m.

REPORT ON ACTION(S) TAKEN IN CLOSED SESSION

No action was taken in closed session.

ACTIONS ITEMS

8. Action on Expulsion Case No. 3/27/93, ID No. 82112.

a. Action No. 1 - Finding of Fact.

A motion was made by Walter Hancock, seconded by Susan Short, that Student No. 3/27/93, I.D. No. 82112 did in fact, violate Education Code Section 48900 (b):

Possessed, sold, or otherwise furnished any firearm, knife, explosive, or other dangerous object, unless, in the case of possession of any object of this type, the pupil had obtained written permission to possess the item from a certificated school employee, which is concurred in by the principal or the designee of the principal.

The Governing Board also found that other means of correction have not been successful to bring about proper conduct. Due to the nature of the act, the presence of the pupil causes a continuing danger to the physical safety of the pupil or others.

Motion unanimously carried.

b. Action No. 2 - Action Pending Expulsion.

A motion was made by Thomas Robertson, seconded by Marie Thomas, to expel Student No. 3/27/93, I.D. No. 82112 for the period of the suspension from school. The expulsion was then suspended and the student was readmitted to Palermo School. The Governing Board recommended the following rehabilitation plan:

- (1) The student continue to be enrolled at Palermo School, on probation through June 2007.
- (2) The student participate in a counseling program approved by the Principal of Palermo School. Parent counseling is recommended.
- (3) The student demonstrate proper respect to and follow all directions of school officials.

ACTIONS ITEMS

8. Action on Expulsion Case No. 3/27/93, ID No. 82112.
 - b. Action No. 2 - Action Pending Expulsion (continued)
 - (4) The student demonstrate proper attitude toward school work, maintain a good attendance record, and demonstrate good school conduct with no disruptions.
 - (5) The student adhere to all laws and regulations, federal, state, and local, as a demonstration of rehabilitation success.
 - (6) The student fully adhere to a Behavior Plan developed by the Principal.

If the student successfully completes the recommended behavior plan and maintains proper respect and conduct, the Order of Expulsion may be expunged from the student's school records upon meeting requirements for graduation from the Palermo Union School District, subject to approval of the Governing Board.

If the contract is seriously violated, the suspension of the Expulsion Order will be revoked by the Superintendent upon the student's commission of any of the acts enumerated in Section 48900, or any violation of the District's rules and regulations governing pupil conduct, or any of the conditions noted herein.

Upon revocation of the suspension of the expulsion, the student shall be expelled under the terms of the original expulsion order and the Principal has the authority to refer the student to the Palermo Community Day School for school attendance

Motion unanimously carried.
