



DISCIPLINE POLICY

A variety of techniques is used for behavior modification:

- Active listening, discussion, or re-direction is used initially. (Recognition for appropriate behavior is used constantly to reinforce desirable patterns.)
- Removal from an activity or time-out is utilized if former strategies are unsuccessful.
- Behavioral reward charts/contracts may be utilized for resistant problem areas.
- However, if a child's behavior becomes detrimental to the safety of others, or to the program operations, the child will be temporarily removed from the classroom.

If all these measures are still unsuccessful, the Palermo Children Center retains the right to request the parent to remove their child. Termination of services may be considered if problems can't be resolved.
