



## GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

It is important that you and your son/daughter know the Grade Point Average (GPA) promotion and graduation requirements for Palermo School. Please read carefully the following school policy regarding promotion and graduation requirements.

Any seventh (7th) grade student earning less than a cumulative yearly 2.0 GPA as a seventh grader will be required to attend summer school, study hall, after school tutoring, etc. The extra assistance will continue until the student achieves a 2.0 GPA.

Eighth (8th) grade students must maintain a 2.0 "C" cumulative yearly grade point average. Grade values are as follows.

A = 4 Points

B = 3 Points

C = 2 Points

D = 1 Points

F = 0 Points

Any 8th grade student not meeting the cumulative 2.0 grade point average will:

1. Have a notice sent home each quarter indicating that the student is not meeting the graduation standard.
2. Be required to attend after school tutoring, Saturday Opportunity School, study hall, etc. The extra assistance shall continue until the student achieves a 2.0 GPA.
3. Not participate in the graduation ceremony.
4. Not receive a diploma.

**NOTE:** If an eighth grade student's GPA falls below the 2.0 GPA benchmark, parents will be notified as soon as it occurs, or at mid-quarter, whichever occurs first.
